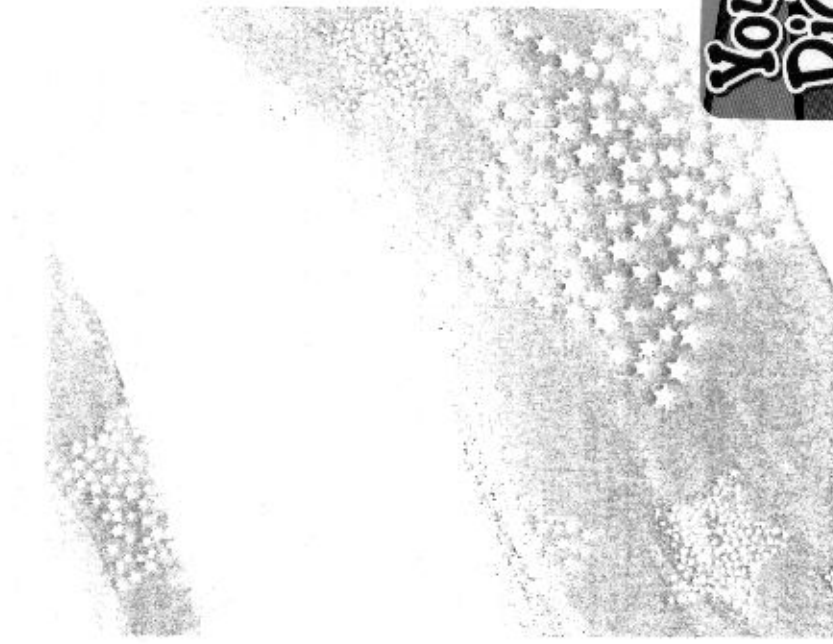

In 1979, Hazel Edgcomb, my mother-in-law, encouraged me to apply for the postal clerk exam. She was retiring from that position after 25 years at the Knoxville Post Office. I took her advice, launching a 30 year postal and philatelic teaching career. Through the Benjamin Franklin Stamp Club, Junior Philatelists of America, and Stamp Camp USA years, Hazel was my best encourager. In the early 1980's she began soaking and sorting stamps for us, where her behind-the-scenes efforts became invaluable.

This past Sunday, after a four month battle with cancer, Hazel went to be with the Lord. Right up to the very end, she continued to sort and clip stamps, instructing Aunt Vivian (her sister) about the process so that Vivian could continue her efforts. Hazel was looking forward to today's event with expectation. The evening before her passing, our daughter, Shannon, called me out in front of Hazel's home. There was a beautiful vertical rainbow! We both knew her journey would soon be over, and that today's event would be a success. MOM, thanks for teaching us all to believe in our dreams. May you now be blessed and at peace.
