Cheryl Edgecomb, an establishing member and present CEO and Executive Director of Stamp Camp USA who also serves as Youth Exhibiting Chairman for the American Association of Philatelic Exhibitors, and Janet Klug, president of the American Philatelic Society and Vice Chairman of the Smithsonian Institution's National Postal Museum Council of Philatelists, are overseas instructors in the camp.

Postmaster General Sheena Glasgow said, "The Cayman Islands Postal Service is pleased that Butterfield Bank has signed up to sponsor Stamp Camp and help us formally launch our Youth Philately program".
